What is the LC?	The Logistics Center (LC) is a scalable operation that supports resource management and movement control during emergencies.
Where does an LC provide support?	A Logistics Center (LC) expands the logistics function in a local or state EOC by serving as an entity that can manage large volumes of resources.
How does the LC Plan benefit my jurisdiction?	The LC Plan outlines the procedures for the activation and operation of a logistics center. The guide has been written to support a cross-functional logistics center staff consisting of federal, state and local logistics professionals, procurement officers, vendors and transportation staff.

Why an LC?

The mission of the LC is to verify, process, acquire, allocate, track, and fulfill resource requests. The LC Manual outlines how to execute the key responsibilities listed below:

- ü Work with EOC Operations and EOC Planning Sections to refine resource requirements.
- ü Follow prioritization from the Command Element (CE) and verify resource requests.
- ü Acquire requested resources to support response operations.
- ü Develop resource delivery transportation plans.
- ü Track acquired resources.
